



Rules Summary

Since the NCAA has updated the penalty options available to the officials. We have created a summary of the “aggressive fouls” and the options available to the officials. Please see the NCAA 2010-12 Rules for Ice Hockey for more detailed explanations

The Following infractions carry a DQ as the only option for the officials...

Excessive Roughness	Fighting or Punching
Kicking a Player	Leaving the players’ bench or penalty bench during an altercation.
Spitting (ACHA Only)	

The Following infractions carry a Major and Game Misconduct or DQ as the options for the officials...

Interference (with spectator)	Slew-footing
Spearing	Butt-Ending
Contact to the Head	Hitting from behind into boards or goal cage
Swinging stick during altercation.	

The Following infraction carries Major or a DQ as the options for the officials...

Head-Butting

The Following infractions carry a Minor or Major and Game Misconduct as the options for the officials...

Hitting After the Whistle

The Following infractions carry a Minor and Misconduct, Game Misconduct or DQ as the options for the officials...

Shooting Puck after the Whistle (at the Goalie)

The Following infractions carry a Minor, Major, Game Misconduct or DQ as the options for the officials...

Hitting From Behind	Clipping
Kneeing	Slashing
Cross-Checking	Taunting
Elbowing Body Checking (Women’s)	High Sticks
